The Teachers Federation has called a Stop Work for teaching staff for **Wednesday 27th June**

Glen Innes Public School will be **non operational** on that day.

Congratulations to all involved in the two carnivals last Friday. The weather was not particularly cooperative but the spirit shown at both venues was terrific.

We are very satisfied with the way the concept of the alternative carnival for non-qualified competitors and infants has developed over the past three years. We have increased attendance at school on the day and increased the number of students participating in sporting activities. As students at both carnivals earn house points at the carnivals, they all contribute to the overall house points that decides the winning house for the year.

The Scope and Sequence developed by Miss Lawrence has ensured that students are trained in all areas of field events over a number weeks as well ALL of the 8 years and above students competing in the trials. This has led to an increased number of overall participants over the three years as students build confidence and discover skills they didn't know they had in various field events.

On a separate matter the P&C operate a very successful school canteen program for the benefit of students at the school. The canteen provides a healthy food

menu and is currently open five days a week.

Recently however there has been a significant drop off in the volunteers available to help in the canteen. This is largely due to illness, work commitments and people moving out of the district. The continued operation of the canteen is dependent on the availability of volunteers.

Next term we will be highlighting the work of the canteen and looking for some new volunteers. A few hours once a fortnight or month would be much appreciated. We will also be publicising any short term vacancies where a regular volunteer is unable to come one week and asking for casual volunteers to step in as well.
